### Who May Apply

High School Seniors enrolling for the 2010 fall semester as College Freshmen are eligible as well as

College Undergraduates enrolling for the 2010 fall semester as a Sophomore, Junior or Senior!

Students who have previously received a CFIC scholarship may apply again.

Extra weight will be given to students who are currently employed in the grocery industry and/or students who are enrolled in an accredited food industry undergraduate curriculum.

### Who Is Eligible

- **Student** whose **parent** is a permanent, **full-time** employee, who has been employed for at least **one-year** (as of 1/1/10) by a CFIC Retail, Wholesale or Supplier Member Firm.

OR

- **Student** who is a **part-time** employee and who has been employed for at least **six-months** (as of 1/1/10) by a CFIC Retail, Wholesale or Supplier Member Firm.

**NOTE:** The food industry employee (whether a parent or student) must work at a Retail, Wholesale or Supplier Member location in **North or South Carolina**, and must be employed at the time the winners are selected in May; qualified scholarship recipients may attend a college located in any state.
